Free Products	Update Interval	Transmission Interval
<b>AIRMET</b>	As Available	5 minutes
<b>Convective SIGMET</b>	As Available then at 15 minute intervals for 1 hour	5 minutes
<b>METAR / SPECI</b>	1 minute (where available), otherwise, As Available	5 minutes
<b>NEXTRAD Reflectivity (CONUS)</b>	~5 minutes (10 minutes for clear air mode)	15 minutes
<b>NEXTRAD Reflectivity (Regional)</b>	~5 minutes (10 minutes for clear air mode)	2.5 minutes
<b>NOTAM –D/FDC</b>	As Available	10 minutes
<b>PIREP</b>	As Available	10 minutes
<b>SIGMET</b>	As Available, then at 15 minute intervals for 1 hour	5 minutes
<b>SUA Status</b>	As Available	10 minutes
<b>TAF /AMEND</b>	8 hours	10 minutes
<b>Temperature Aloft</b>	12 hours	10 minutes
<b>Winds Aloft</b>	12 hours	10 minutes
